Rooted in values of service, education, and holistic care, the Congregation actively contributes to the **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** through its diverse apostolates of education, health, social and pastoral care across the globe. We present below the alignment of JMJJ's initiatives with selected **SDGs**:

SDG 1-Building resilience of poor and vulnerable people

Activities:

- Create educational opportunities for vulnerable children to build a better future.
- Provide market-relevant training, particularly women and youth to improve the economic well-being of their families.

Impact: Generating self-reliance and breaking intergenerational cycles of poverty.



SDG3-Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being

Activities:

- Reach out through healthcare facilities and wellness centers in urban and rural communities.
- Organise health camps and awareness programs on hygiene, nutrition, and disease prevention.
- Offer homecare facilities for elderly, chronic illness individuals, and persons with disabilities.

Impact: Improving access to healthcare and preventive wellness in underserved communities.



SDG 4-Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education

Activities:

- Impart education service to children from tribal, rural, and underserved slum communities.
- Provide remedial classes for the children and youth in underprivileged and remote areas.
- Deliver life skills training and value-based educational programs.

Impact: Enhancing literacy, bridging educational gaps, and forming responsible citizens.



SDG5- Gender equality and empowering all women and girls.

Activities:

- Rehabilitation homes for women trafficked, domestic violence, displaced women through formal and non-formal education, skill-building programs.
- Formation of Self-Help Groups (SHGs) for women's financial inclusion.
- Advocate on women's rights and protection from abuse.

Impact: Promoting equal opportunities and safe environments for women and girls.



SDG 6 – Clean water and sanitation

Activities:

- Awareness campaigns promoting sanitation in rural villages and urban slums.
- Construction and refurbishment of hygienic disabled friendly toilets in villages, schools.
- Initiatives for water conservation and sustainable rainwater harvesting .

Impact: Dignified sanitation access and better health outcomes.



SDG 10 – Reduced Inequalities

Activities

- Inclusive education for children with disabilities
- Migrant assistance and social integration initiatives
- Holistic pastoral and psychological services for vulnerable populations

Impact: Building inclusive societies and promoting social justice.
