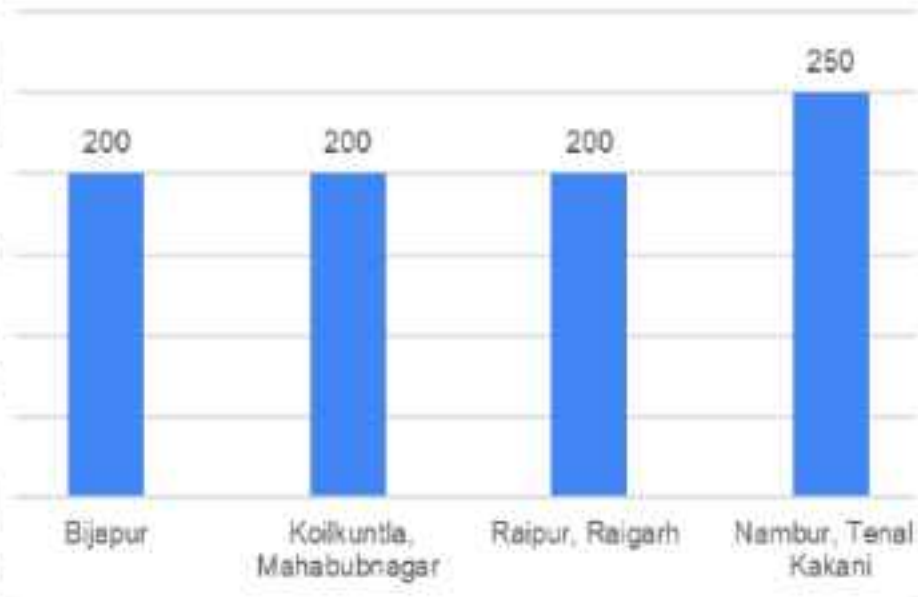
# Women Empowerment

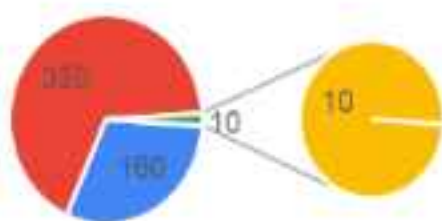
# Self Employment training for Women

- Inspirational quotes and pamphlets on career guidance are posted in the whatsapp group.

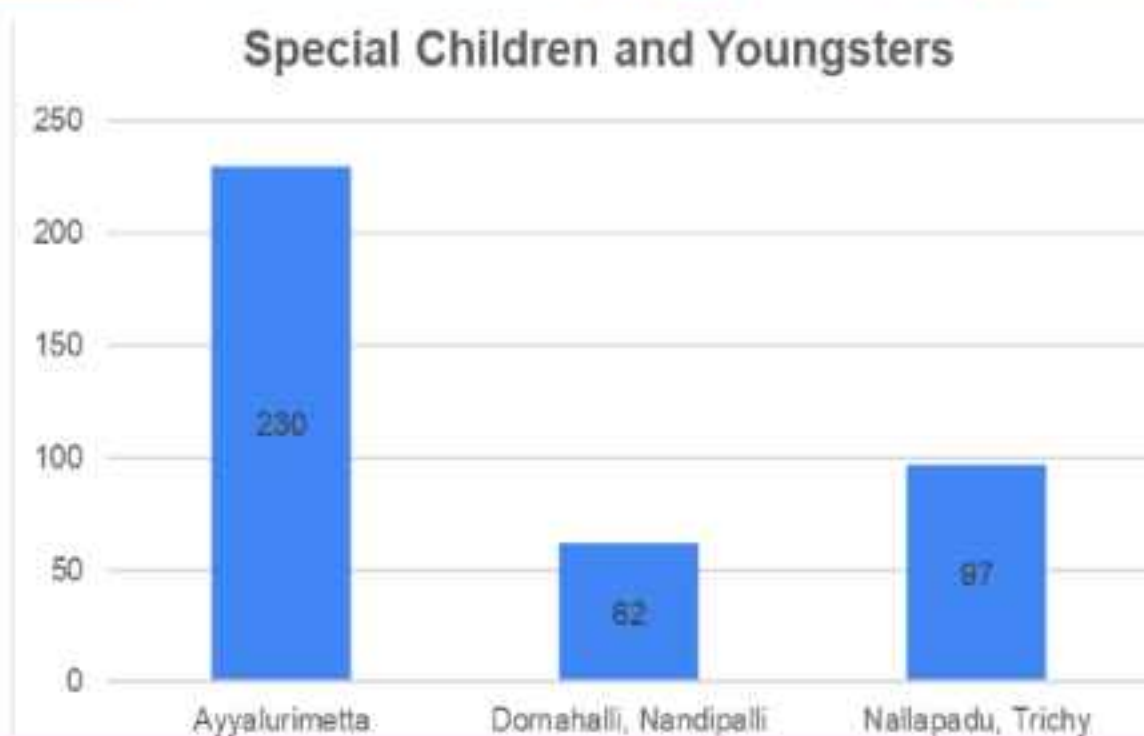


# Special Children and Youngsters Needs

# Rehabilitation Homes for Women and Children in Difficult Circumstances

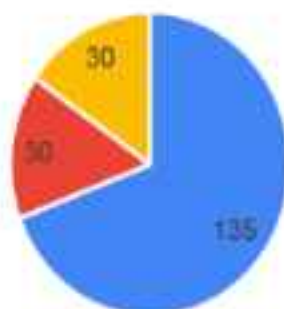


## Key Interventions

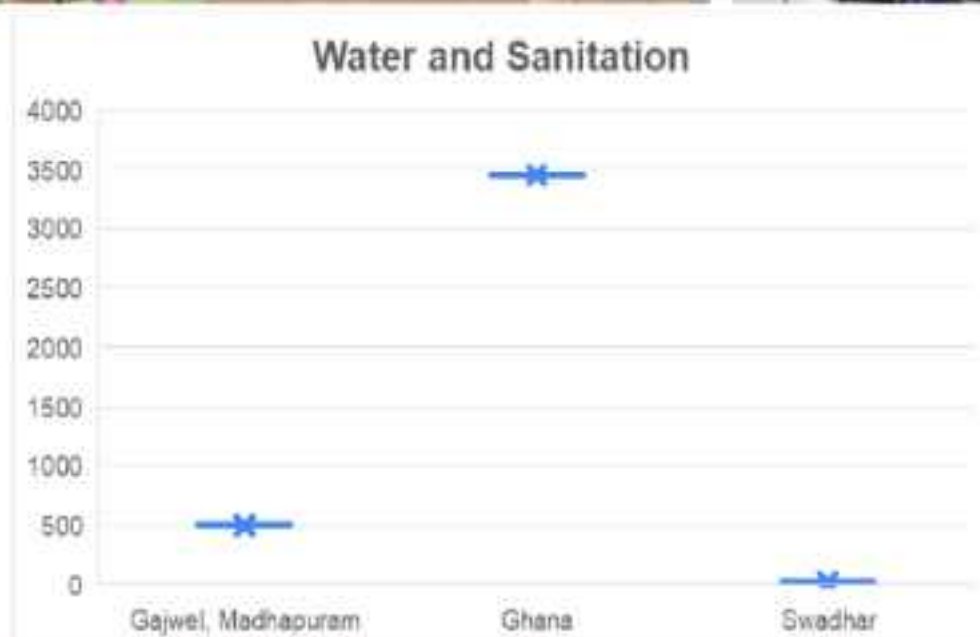


# Water and Sanitation

- Created a daily livelihood opportunity, which improved their economic condition and better living standards.

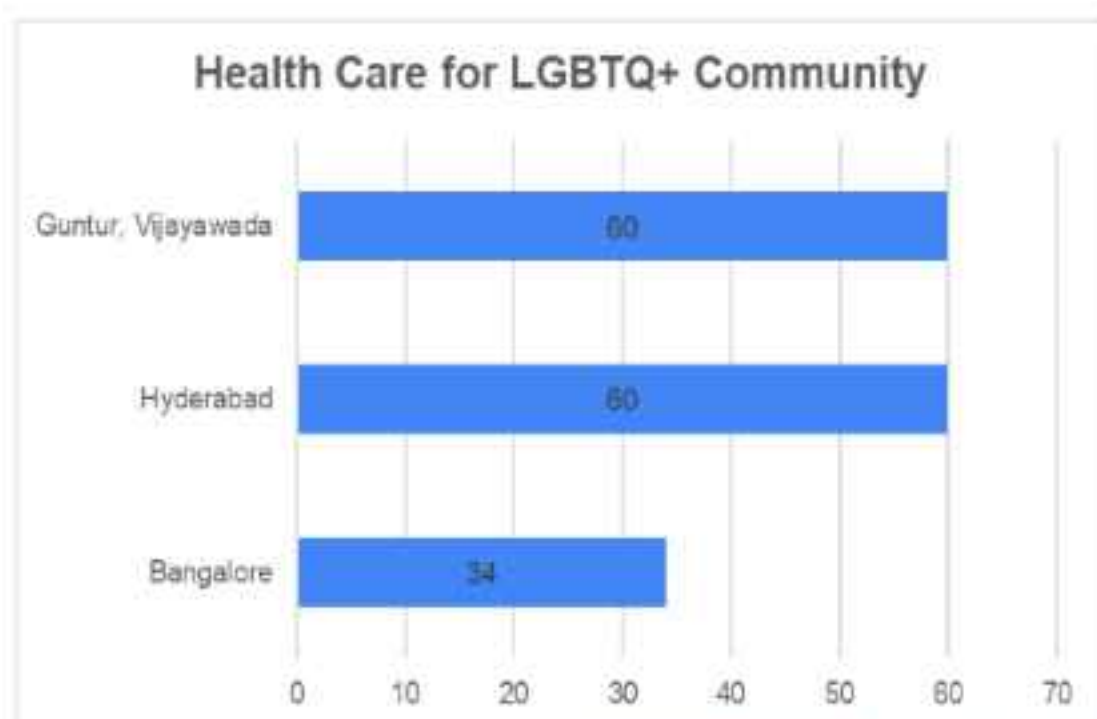


# Inclusive Health Care for LGBTQ+ Community

- Medical Camp for Migrant Workers with health check-ups and medication.

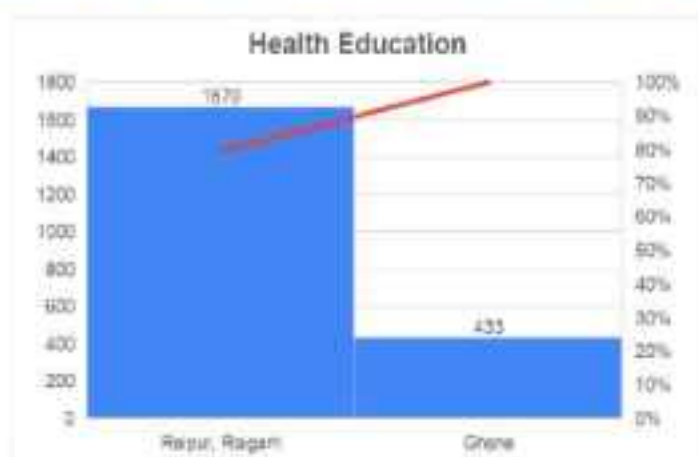


# Health Education

# Peace Club Initiatives



## Key Interventions

- Aimed to instill in students of 10 schools the spirit of harmony, tolerance, and inner balance in an age marked by distractions and stress.
- Focused on the eight dimensions of peace and their practical application in daily life-Peace Awareness, Inner Peace, Inter-religious Peace, Peace with Nature, Peace through Empathy, Role Models of Peace, Peace Pledge.



# Ecological Initiatives



## Key Interventions

- Organized sessions on the care for environment and distributed saplings.
- Provided alternative therapies and home-based care for chronically ill patients and elderly persons.
- Reflective prayer session emphasizing peace, unity, and care for creation.
- Promotion of environmentally sustainable behaviors through reflection, meditation, and community celebrations.
- Laudato Si Villages Initiative promoting environmental consciousness and green living in Khammam.



# Formation of Safeguarding Commissions & Oath Taking



## Key Interventions

- Capacity-building through monthly CSC meetings, review sessions, and policy drafting workshops.
- Establishment of Safeguarding email IDs and reporting mechanisms.
- Appointment of Safeguarding Officers and Unit-level Commissions in schools and ministries.

- Development of multi-institutional safeguarding policies and codes of conduct.
- Partnerships for youth awareness programs and clergy formation.
- Sharing policy copies, brochures, and safeguarding resources.



# Awareness Programs for Students



## Key Interventions

- Student-centred teaching methodologies using activities, videos, charts, demonstrations.
- Sessions conducted for thousands of students in Gajwel, Aleru, Mahabubnagar, Achempet, Mudinepalli, Vijayawada, Don Bosco CBSE, Atkinson School, Christu Jyothi, Timarni, Konapuram, and others.
- Youth Convention at Kurnool reached 2000+ youth.



# Teachers' Training for Safe School Environments



## Key Interventions

- Establishment of School Safeguarding Commissions.
- Training in responding to disclosures of Abuse and reporting Mechanism.
- Teachers were trained to integrate safeguarding into school routines and monitoring.



# Involvement of JMJs in UN Activities through VIVAT International



## Key Interventions

- Involvement in the VIVAT contact persons meet every four months.
- Attended internship during Human Rights Council at Geneva.
- Participated in the workshops organised in Ghana and India by National Contact persons.
- Enrolled JMJ schools in Youth Engagement through Model United Nations (Model UN)
- Initiation of Issue Based Groups for women, children and migrants.





## Key Impacts

- Provided daily after-school coaching through remedial centres for children from migrant and marginalized families.
- Promoted continued education and personal development among marginalized children and youth.
- Focused on leadership, financial independence, and environmental stewardship among vulnerable women.
- Availing entitlements, physiotherapy, inclusive education for the special children and youngsters.
- Youth groups are formed, guided, empowered for the active participation and contribution towards social responsibility.
- Health awareness and access to safe drinking water improved wellbeing.
- Trained women and youngsters in skill development, vocational training, tailoring, block printing, and income-generating activities.
- Organized law awareness campaigns, Constitution Day observances, and community advocacy initiatives.
- Clean & Green programs, tree plantation drives, and eco-spiritual initiatives deepened the commitment to "Care for Our Common Home."
- Observed international important days emphasizing civic values and gender equality.
- Strengthened partnerships with local government schemes and faith-based networks.
- Expansion of safeguarding structure from congregation to unit level.
- Large-scale awareness among students, teachers, youth, religious, and clergy.
- Professionalisation of safeguarding through diplomas, collaborations, and policy frameworks.
